Gold medalist at the 2003 Western Canada Summer Games.

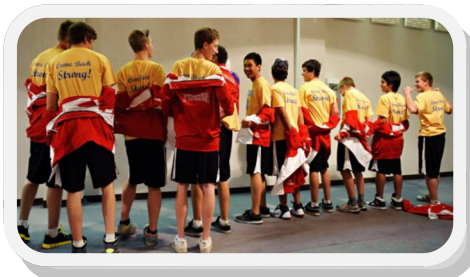
