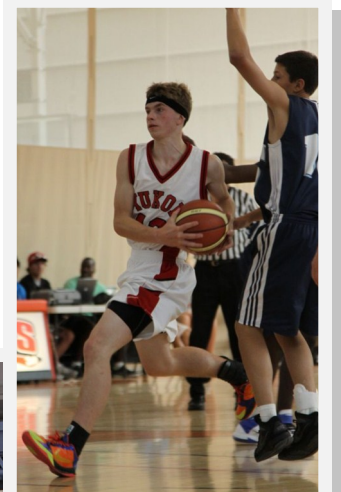

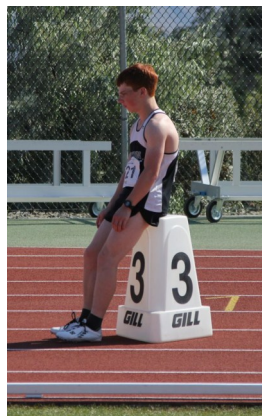
TENNIS

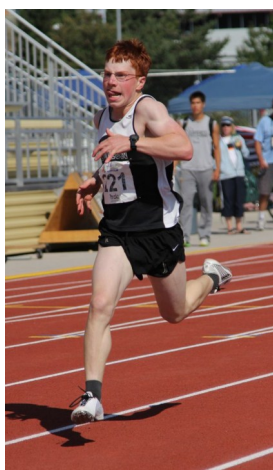


ATHLETICS
