Kids Recreation Fund Guidelines for Equipment

The purpose of the Kids Recreation Fund (KRF) is to assist children and youth who are unable to participate in sport and recreational activities due to their family's financial hardship.

What is the KRF?

The KRF is a special fund administered by Sport Yukon and supported in part by the Government of Yukon, which helps families with the cost of registration fees, supplies and sport specific hard equipment, so their children can participate in healthy activities. A maximum of **\$400 per child** is available under the KRF per year. This program is for Yukon residents only.

Who is eligible?

- Children and youth (aged 0 to 19 years) from families whose **net income** is under \$45,000 per year (as per Revenue Canada 2010 Notice of Assessment)
- Children and youth who, due to special family circumstances (such as recent financial hardship, family illness or large family size)

What does it pay for?

Funds may be provided to help with the cost of participating in sport and recreational activities in the Yukon.

How do I apply for Equipment?

Fill out a KRF application form and submit along with either receipts for reimbursement or a purchase quote from the store providing the equipment. For reimbursements, fill out a **separate form** for each child with the total and attach receipts. For price quotes please fill out a **separate form** for each child and for each store providing equipment. **Receipts will not be accepted if older than 3 months from the date of application.**

Examples of equipment FUNDED under the KRF

Sport Specific Hard Equipment, Bikes, Strollers, Trampolines, Running/Court Shoes, Jungle Gym/Swing Sets, Art Supplies (art supplies will be reviewed on an individual basis).

Examples of equipment NOT FUNDED under the KRF

Clothing, Jackets, Street Shoes, Mitts, Toques, Uniforms, Board Games, Video Games, Toys, Car Seats

What we require

- Revenue Canada's 2010 Notice of Assessment for the family.
- A copy of the child's Yukon Health Care Card.
