

Kids Recreation Fund Guidelines

The purpose of the Kids Recreation Fund (KRF) is to assist Yukon children and youth who are unable to participate in activities because of financial hardship.

What is the KRF?

The KRF is a special fund administered by Sport Yukon and supported in part by the Government of Yukon, which helps Yukon families with the cost of fees, supplies, and hard equipment, so their children can participate in healthy activities. A maximum of \$500 per child is available under the KRF per year.

Who is eligible?

- ⌘ Children and youth (aged 0 to 19 years) from the families whose family **net income** is under \$45,000 per year (as per Revenue Canada 2009 Notice of Assessment)
- ⌘ Children and youth who, due to special family circumstances (such as recent financial hardship, family illness, large family size, family crisis.)

What does it pay for?

Funds may be provided to help with the cost of participating in sport, recreation, arts, cultural, and social activities in the Yukon. In-Yukon travel may be considered on an individual basis.

How to apply?

Please use the Application Form to apply.

- ⌘ Revenue Canada's 2009 Notice of Assessment.
- ⌘ A copy of the child's Government Issued form of ID.
- ⌘ Funds are paid to the organization providing the activity.
- ⌘ Receipts for equipment will only be accepted if less than 3 months old.
- ⌘ Applications may be submitted at any time.
- ⌘ Applicants will be informed of the decision after the 14 day processing period.
